Life Questions:

Monday – From the beginning of the fall of man – God has promised that one of their offspring will defeat Satan. What promises of God can you dwell on today knowing that God will do what he promises?

Tuesday – Micah was written around 742 to 687 B.C. foretelling the birth of Jesus – how can we rest today with the knowledge that God’s timing is perfect?

Wednesday – The book of Isaiah tells of a virgin giving birth to a son who will be called Immanuel, which means God With Us. God has a purpose for each of us – what a privilege it is to serve the God who made us! Mary served as she was called, how do you feel God is calling you to serve?

Thursday – The birth of the Savior in Bethlehem was followed by King Herod ordering the boys in and around Bethlehem that were 2 years old and younger to be killed. Our lives are filled with the good and the bad – are you still able to thank God for what you have and where you are today?

Friday – How are we passing on to our children & grandchildren the faith we have in Christ?

Saturday – Do you think Caesar Augustus knew he was part of God’s plan in fulfilling scripture? Take comfort today that God is using you in his plan to reach others so that others will know God’s Son Jesus!
